

Introduction

Past seasons have had issues with configuring the external zones consistently and correctly. Because their configuration can be the same from season to season, a new feature was added to perform this task. It:

- sets the appropriate Seasonal Configuration settings;
- creates programs;
- creates Team Official subroles; and,
- creates Volunteer subroles.

Usage

To use this feature:

1. Log in as an administrator.
2. Verify that the appropriate Season exists.
3. Verify that the appropriate Age Categories exist.
4. Navigate to the Manage Seasonal Configuration screen.
5. Select the season using the drop box on the page.
6. Click the Configure External Zones button. This will open a dialog box.
7. Deselect any zones as appropriate. In general use, all zones will remain selected.
8. Click the Install Configurations button. This will display a progress box.

Notes

- This feature is only available to administrators and the Configure External Zones button is only visible to them.
- This feature should be used before any other configuration is performed for the external zones. A good time to use it is right after the age categories have been created for the season.
- This feature should not be used on a zone that has already been configured for the season.
- Categories of changes:
 - The seasonal configurations are minimally altered to turn the default configuration into one suitable for the external zone. Other settings (e.g., email templates) are unaffected.
 - Programs are added for community and club in the appropriate jurisdiction for the matching age category. Existing programs are not removed.
 - Community U8 and under: mixed
 - Community U9 and up: boys and girls
 - Premier U7 and up: boys and girls
 - If an age category is not defined (e.g., U8), then it will have no programs created.

- Team official subroles are created at the zone level. Existing team official subroles are not removed.
 - Assistant coach
 - Coach
 - Team manager
 - Technical trainer
- Volunteer subroles are created at the zone level. Existing subroles are not removed.
 - Default TO
- Each zone is configured independently and the first failure stops the process. E.g., if the 3rd of 8 zones fails to configure properly, the first 2 zones will have succeeded in their configuration and zones 4 through 8 can be retried by unchecking zones 1 through 3.

This will install Seasonal Configurations, programs, team official roles, and volunteer roles for the selected zones for the 2018 - 2019 Indoor Season season.

This feature changes specific seasonal configuration settings and will overwrite their existing values. The others will not be affected. If changes have been made prior to using this feature, a review of the resulting settings is highly recommended.

This feature adds appropriate programs, team official roles, or volunteer roles. Any existing items will be preserved and the new items will be added to them.

A pre-existing volunteer role with a default team official role may cause a conflict.
